Costs

1 Person Room - £85 per night

5. Entry Fee

Seniors - £60 per gymnast

Juniors (13 - 19) - £60 per gymnast

Youth (12 – 18) - £60 per gymnast

Pre-Youth (11 – 16) - £60 per gymnast

Aspire - £40 per gymnast



6. Judges

Each team should supply at least 1 nominated judge per day of competition. If you are unable to do so you will be fined £250.

Small teams with a small entry can arrange to share a Judge. Please contact Mark for information on how this can be arranged.

Judges should be submitted via Acro Companion in your entry process. Please ensure you provide their email address, phone number and make sure you have a judge assigned to each session.

7. Insurance

Each competitor **MUST** be insured at their own expense. The organiser cannot be held responsible.

8. Equipment

Both the warm-up floor and the main competition floor will be Gymnova floors.

Tie Braking

In the event of a tie FIG tie breaking rules will apply.

Qualifications and Finals

Aspire

All aspire gymnasts will perform their routine twice with both routines being added together to form their overall score.

FIG Levels

All FIG gymnasts will perform their Balance and Dynamic routines in qualifications with their overall score combined to generate the finals list which will then be put into a randomised compete order.

Pre-Youth will perform the following routines for their finals –

Women's Pairs: Balance

Mixed Pairs: Dynamic

Men's Pairs: Balance

Women's Groups: Dynamic

Men's Groups: Balance

All other levels will perform their Combined routine for their finals.

Once all routines have been performed all scores will be added together (Qualifications and Finals) to finalise the rankings.

Finals

Finals will not be zero finals. All scores from qualifications and finals will be added together to form the overall score

Depending on how many gymnasts are in the category will determine how many will make it through into the finals.

If there are 12 or fewer partnerships in a category, then the cut to the finals will be 6.



If there are between 12 and 30 partnerships in a category, then the cut to the finals will be 8.

If there are more than 30 partnerships in a category, then the cut to the finals will be 10.

11. Tariff Sheets and Music

Tariff sheets and music will be provided through Acro Companion. Once your registration has been accepted and inputted into the system your coaches will receive their gymnasts tariff sheets and music upload locations.

It is very important that during your registration all coaches email addresses are correct as this will delay your tariff sheets getting to you.

12. Finances

All monies will be paid in full to guarantee your registration.

No refunds will be given after you have paid.

The event has been fully booked in the last 5 years and we again anticipate that we will have to cut the entry process when the planned number of routines has been received, so avoid disappointment and plan early.
